## Zurich's Baur au Lac sets sail for the summer with new private boating experiences

Since 1844 the iconic heritage property Baur au Lac has always made the most of its Zurich lakeside locale. In celebration of the warmer months, it has introduced an exclusive experience aboard another heritage icon - with the city's oldest saloon boat, the [Tugenia](#).

Built in 1904 by Johannes Faul, the *Tugenia* has been used as a cab boat since its debut nearly 120 years ago, first residing on Lake Lucerne before finding its way to Lake Zurich at the turn of the last century. A typical saloon ship of its time – resplendent with its mahogany sideboard, larch under hull and oak keel - its virtually silent electric motor will transport up to eight guests of Baur au Lac on a scenic excursion across endless hues of blue at speeds of up to 10km/h.

Guests can choose between three arrangements, each with an excursion time of two hours, from **Bathing Fun** to **Sightseeing** and a **Bespoke Individual** excursion crafted entirely to the voyager's preference.

Guests can also opt to indulge in an exquisite picnic basket comprising fresh local cheeses, charcuterie, breads, chilled rose wine and homemade iced tea to name just a few of the delectable bites that will ensure a culinary sojourn of the highest order.

Baur au Lac's New Boat Excursions start from CHF 645 (per person). Fine Dining Picnics from CHF 75 per person. The arrangements vary according to season.
